

The bills Steven Ramsey went over at 5/20 DAC meeting is as follows:

- SB 500 (deregulation of honey producers);
- HB 618 (Death Certification Bill- It increases who may perform medical certification, allows for endless delegation of data entry, and provides immunity for data entry persons);
- SB 354-(Mandating DHSS to provide expensive amino acid formula without a funding sources, subject to appropriations, however, the expectation is that we can use a federal block grant (which we cannot) to provide the funding))-This bill was pushed by one of Scott Mar's clients;
- SB 341 (two portions are useful for LPHAs, 1) Upon request a licensed childcare facility must provide a parent information regarding if any children have an exemption from getting immunized; (2) Mandates a Safe Sleep Policy for childcare facilities for those children under the age of 1 year of age);
- HB 531-requires childproof containers for liquid nicotine products;
- There are also a number of "awareness" days that were passed.
