





I. Screen Prototype in Search MODE – Task View/Update Case Summary will take you to this screen




Include last changed user id and last changed date in grid.

II. Screen Prototype in ADD MODE – Task Add Case Summary will take you to this screen
- Need to add the calendar icon next to date field



III. Screen Prototype in UPDATE MODE – After searching, the update link will take you to the Update Screen - Only Change that can be made is to the number of cases by increasing or decreasing it.



IV. Validate the following:

- a. The page displays as per web standards
- b. Drop down lists are loaded correctly:
 - **Condition** (SURVWEB_LOOKUP_VALUE table – LIST_NAME: CASE SUMMARY CONDITION NAME)
 - **Age Group** (SURVWEB_LOOKUP_VALUE table – LIST_NAME: CASE SUMMARY AGE GROUP)
 - **Jurisdiction** (SURVWEB_REF_JURISDICTION TABLE ?)
- c. Paging will be available in the list grids to show five at a time and add paging when there are more than five rows of information. Keep the current sort order when paging.
- d. Sort list as follows:
- e. When the user scrolls, save the position. When the screen reloads, use the latest scroll position to redisplay the screen in the same position as it was before the reload.
- f. The calendar controls works correctly
- g. Correct information displayed.
- h. No more than the maximum number of characters can be entered into the following fields:
 - **Add / Update Case Summary**
 - Report Date – 8 (must have day in this date so it must be exactly 8 digits)
 - Number of Cases – 5 digits
- i. The following error messages display in the order of the fields on the screen if applicable when the user clicks [Add to List](#) or the **Save** button:
 - **Add / Update Case Summary**
 - Report Date is required
 - Condition is required
 - Age Group is required
 - Jurisdiction is required
 - Number of Cases is required
 - Report Date cannot be in future
 - Report Date must be a Sunday date.

- j. Display **mmddyyyy** in red to the right of a Date field that is not a valid date (i.e. does not have a valid month day year combination) as soon as the user leaves the field. Earliest valid date is 01011800.
- k. Display **#####** in red to the right of the field that is not a valid id (i.e. must be a number from 1 to 99999) as soon as the user leaves the field.


V. Buttons & Links

- a. Error Messages - Validation to display messages to the user will not be performed on [Cancel & Return](#)
- b. Waiting - When click a link that will bring up another page, display a popup with the pyramid image and a message such as of "Working, please wait..." as per standards.
- c. Date Fields - When click the calendar icon and select a date, keep the cursor on the date field so the user can tab to the next field.
- d. When click a [Cancel & Return](#) link, return to the previous page.
- e. When click [Save](#) or [Save & Add New](#) links, validate the entry fields in that section and their combinations.
 - ✓ If passes validation,
 1. Add those items to the database
 2. Return the Add Confirmation screen




- 3. If Save and click submit on confirmation page, return Task Page
- 4. If Save & Add New and click submit on confirmation page, return Add Case Summary screen

- ✓ If fails validation, display the error messages above the entry fields in that section.
- f. When click an **Update** link to edit a record,
 - ✓ Return the Update Case Summary page with the information for that row in the fields
 - ✓ Increase should be checked as default
 - ✓ Show its [Save](#), [Save & Add New](#) and [Cancel & Return](#)
 - ✓ When click [Save](#) or [Save & Add New](#), calculate the new amount and return the Update Confirmation Screen.



- g. When click [Delete](#) link to remove a record, display the Delete Confirmation Screen.



- ✓ If the user clicks submit, remove the row from the grid display and return the Search Screen with the previous search results less the row, and if it was the only row, display “No items”.
 - ✓ If the user clicks Cancel & Return, then do not remove the row from the grid display and return to the Search Screen with the previous search results.
- h. Sorting - When click a column header in a grid, check to see if the sort is currently on that column. If so, sort the list on that column ascending or descending (opposite of what it currently is). If not, sort the list on that column ascending. Dates sort include the month, day and year.
- i. Tab Order - The tab order should default as top to bottom left to right unless otherwise stated.

VI. Database routines – Screen Information

- a. Retrieval of the user’s security to display the Update button appropriately
- b. Information will be stored in tables as shown below:

Last changed date should only capture changes to the data, not system changes such as when the record is written to the NETSS files (when SENT TO CDC-DATETIME and CDC NETSS identifier are populated).

Note: SENT_TO_CDC_DATETIME and CDC_NETSS_IDENTIFIER are populated from a Data Warehouse job when the NETSS file is generated.
