### 1. Screen prototype: List Mode (on the List Condition Notes screen)

When the user navigates to the List Condition Notes page, it will be in list mode as follows:

#### Screen Display

- Lock Entry Fields
    - No Wrap
    - Yellow Space is added to right of fields/labels (not in the middle or left)
  - Grids set to 100% of full page
  - Add to List and Clear set to top right most of grid
  - Subheader titles (if needed) are bold
  - No borders on sections/tables
- Paging will be available in the list grids to show five at a time and add paging when there are more than five rows of information. Keep the current sort order when paging.

### 2. Validate the following:

- a. The page displays as per web standards
- b. When on the List Condition Notes screen, then:
  - o All notes for the condition display in the list

- c. All columns display including Date, Note Type, Entered By and Note
- d. The section for the Notes error messages, Notes field label, Note entry textbox, Add to List link and Clear link is hidden
- e. All Notes display the correct information on each screen they appear.
- f. Paging will be available in the grid when there are more than five rows of information, and the default is to initially show five at a time. Keep the current sort order when paging.
- g. Sort the list of notes that are retrieved from database by descending Entry Date, then ascending NOTE\_TYPE.
- h. When the user scrolls, save the position. When the screen reloads, use the latest scroll position to redisplay the screen in the same position as it was before the reload.
- i. Set the width of the Notes column so that it will wrap note text that is too long to fit with the rest of the columns within an 800 x 600 screen.

### 3. Buttons & Links

- a. When click a column header in a grid, check to see if the sort is currently on that column. If so, sort the list on that column ascending or descending (opposite of what it currently is). If not, sort the list on that column ascending. When click a column header to change the sort, restart the user on page 1 of the grid with the new sort order. Dates sort include the month, day and year.

- a. Retrieval of Encounter Dates for notes from the Encounter screen.
