


**Condition 2 - Add Condition**

The following preconditions must be met:

1. Successful log into MOHSAIC WEBSURV application.
2. Search and Add or Search and Select Party


Business Rules:

1. Available diseases in dropdown are based on role (TB roles have TB Disease, TB Infection and MOTT, CD Roles have Animal Bites, Hepatitis, Shigellosis, etc.)
2. Some sections are enabled / disabled based on Disease.
  - a. Refugee Immigrant Class, Vital Status at Diagnosis, Previous Diagnosis, Year of Previous Diagnosis, Multiple Previous Episodes are only available for TB Disease.
  - b. Complication for Adverse Reactions
  - c. Severity of Illness and Vaccination Status for Varicella conditions



Procedure 1: Click Add Condition in the tree.

Expected System Response: The Add Condition screen is returned.




**CONDITION ADDRESS** (determines jurisdiction)

- ✓ if no address, skip to step 11 and the jurisdiction will be determined by the reporter or provider address
- ✓ if an address has been associated to the party, it will show for the address.


Procedure 2: Click Remove link for Condition Address. (Go to Step 4 if no address is shown and you want to select a person address or step 8 for an Institution Address.)

Expected System Response: A pop up message to confirm remove will be returned.




Procedure 3: Click OK

Expected System Response: The Add condition screen will be displayed without an address.




Procedure 4: Click on Person Address(s) link.





Expected System Response: The screen is refreshed. The condition status dropdown is now populated based on the condition. Sections are included for specific diseases:

- ✓ TB DISEASE - Refugee Immigrant Class, Vital Status at Diagnosis, Previous Diagnosis, Year of Previous Diagnosis, Multiple Previous Episodes are only available for TB Disease.
- ✓ ADVERSE REACTIONS - Complication
- ✓ VARICELLA - Severity of Illness and Vaccination Type



**Other Validations:**

- ✓ Year of Previous Diag can only be entered when Prev Diag is Yes
- ✓ Multiple Previous Episodes can only be entered when Prev Diag is Yes
- ✓ One state outbreak is field cannot be entered without the other.
- ✓ Type of Outbreak can only be entered when Outbreak Associated is Yes
- ✓ Pregnant at Diagnosis is only available if client is female.
- ✓ Dates (cannot be in future, cannot be prior to Client's Date of Birth)

**Expected System Response:** The remaining condition variables are available for entry.



**Procedure 13:** Enter Date of Report and Completed By information. Click Search link to add Reporter.




- ✓ No punctuation can be entered in Contact Last Name and First name

- ✓ Dates (cannot be in future, cannot be prior to Client's Date of Birth)

Procedure 14: Enter search criteria (Organization Name, Last Name and First Name if a person, and/or Provider Role). Click Search



Procedure 15: Click the Party Name to select the party.







Procedure 21: Select the provider by clicking on the name link.



Expected System Response: The Medical Provider is shown in the grid. (Repeat steps 19-21 to add additional medical providers.) The first provider will be set as primary.




Procedure 22: Click the N in the Primary column to set the provider as primary.

Expected System Response: The provider will be marked as primary.




Procedure 23: Click Remove next to the Medical Provider Name.

Expected System Response: You will be prompted to verify that you want to remove this information.




Procedure 24: Click OK

Expected System Response: The Add Condition screen will be returned with the medical provider removed from the grid.




Procedure 25: Click Search (Other Facilities)

Expected System Response: The Search Organization screen is returned as a popup.




Procedure 26: Enter search criteria (organization name and/or provider role) and click search button.

Expected System Response: The Search Organization screen is returned with results in grid.




Procedure 27: Select facility by clicking on name link.

Procedure 28: Click the Remove next to the other facility that you want to delete.


Expected System Response: You will be prompted to confirm that you want to remove the information.



Procedure 29: Click OK



Expected System Response: The condition screen will be returned with the facility removed from the grid.




Procedure 30: Scroll if needed, enter comments in box and click add to list.

Procedure 31: Click Save


Expected System Response: Validation failed, error messages returned.

Procedure 32: If jurisdiction is not populated, select the jurisdiction and then Click Save


Expected System Response: A popup message stating the condition has been saved....
