The following preconditions must be met:

1. Successful logon to Web Surveillance Application
2. Search and Select a person.
3. Expand Condition Tree
4. Click on Treatments and enter treatments first (See Treatment test plan)
5. Click on Encounters in the Tree.

Business Rules:

1. Conditions are viewable based on security – TB roles include TB DISEASE, TB INFECTION, and MOTT; CD roles include other conditions such as ANIMAL BITES, HEPATITIS, SHIGELLOSIS, etc.
2. Jurisdiction based security – Edit link is only available to users that have access for the manage jurisdiction. Read only will be shown in the top piece if the user does not have access. Symptoms can be added for any jurisdiction by all users.
3. Encounters are available for TB DISEASE and TB INFECTION only.
4. The TB Infection section is only visible if condition is TB INFECTION.
5. The medications listed in the dropdown are from the treatment records for the condition. Enter treatment records for the condition prior to entering encounter.

Required Entries:

- ✓ Encounter Date
- ✓ Evaluator Last Name and Evaluator First Name
- ✓ DOT selection

Other Validations:

- ✓ Encounter Date must be prior to next encounter date
- ✓ DOT location can only be entered when DOT is YES
- ✓ Dates (cannot be in future, cannot be prior to date of birth).

 Enter Medication and Effects. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select medication in the dropdown (these include the treatments that were entered on the treatment screen.) 2. Select compliance code 3. Select Adverse Effect and click Add Adverse Effect to List. Repeat for all adverse effects for the specific drug. (if no adverse effect, go to the next procedure)	 The Adverse Effect is added to the Adverse Effect Grid. NOTE (This adverse effect is associated to the Medication selected in the dropdown.)		
Procedure #5	Expected System Response	Pass	Fail
 Click Add Medication to List.	 The medication information is added to the grid. NOTE (This medication is associated to the Encounter entered in the top section.)		
Procedure #6	Expected System Response	Pass	Fail
 Repeat steps 4-5 to add additional medication records to this encounter.	 Multiple medication records are shown in the grid.		
Procedure #7	Expected System Response	Pass	Fail
 Click Add Encounter to List	 The encounter is added to the grid.		
Procedure #8	Expected System Response	Pass	Fail
 Repeat steps 4-7 to add additional encounters.	 Multiple encounters records are shown in the grid.		
Procedure #9	Expected System Response	Pass	Fail
 Enter comments and click Add to List	 Comments are added to the grid.		
Procedure #10	Expected System Response	Pass	Fail
 Click Save.	 The Data Saved Screen is returned.		
Procedure #11	Expected System Response	Pass	Fail
 Click Encounters in the Treeview.	 The Encounters Screen is returned.		
Procedure #12	Expected System Response	Pass	Fail
 Scroll down to view the encounters grid.	 The Grids on the Encounters Screen are shown.

 Procedure #13 Click Edit in the Encounter Grid.	 The information is shown in the entry fields and secondary grid (medications).		
 Procedure #14 Click Edit in the Medications Grid.	 The medication information is shown in the entry fields and the third grid (adverse effects).		
 Procedure #15 Change the Medication or Compliance Code and/or Remove or Add Adverse Effects.	 Changes made to entry fields and the adverse effects grid is updated.		
 Procedure #16 Click Replace above the Medications Grid.	 The medication grid is updated.		
 Procedure #17 Add additional medications or Remove Medications.	 The medication grid is updated.		
 Procedure #18 Click Replace above the Encounters Grid.	 The encounter grid is updated.		
 Procedure #19 Click Remove for a record in the Encounters Grid.	 The encounter grid is updated.		
 Procedure #20 Click OK.	 The record is removed from the Encounter Grid.		
 Procedure #21 Click Save	 Data Saved Screen is returned
