The Department of Health and Senior Services, in partnership with Walgreens, will hold influenza vaccination clinics in Jefferson City and each district office. If you have a state employee health plan, Walgreens will bill the medical or pharmacy plan and no payment will be necessary by the employee at the time of service.

In the event an employee does not have a medical or pharmacy plan or the plan is not contracted with Walgreens, a charge will be incurred. Checks will be accepted with checks payable to Walgreens, no cash please. The cost of the vaccine is reimbursable

by most insurance companies and through the Cafeteria Plan. Forms will be available at the clinic to submit to your insurance coverage provider for reimbursement.

Walgreens will donate the value of one life-saving vaccine every time a customer receives a dose of flu vaccine. They will also donate \$1 (up to \$100,000) for every dose of flu vaccine sold to individuals that self-identify as supporters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation.
