This provides a second level of LPHA review (i.e. internal data review) if desired. This must be clicked to indicate to DHSS that the data is ready for review and submission to CDC.</p>	<p>On the top bar of the EpiTrax Morbidity Record</p>  <p>DHSS staff perform a final review of the data, then click the "Approve at State" option once the case has been reviewed and found to be complete for submission to CDC.</p>
